- The Philippine Red Cross will conduct the Million Volunteer Run (MVR) 5 on December 8, 2019, 5:00 AM at the entrance of Kalibo International Airport to Kalibo Pastrana Park, Kalibo, AKlan. Please see attached enclosure which is self-explanatory.
- 2. Registration fee is Php 700.00 per runner inclusive of singlet, string bag and race bib and Php 100.00 for student without inclusion of the race collaterals. Participation of the said event shall be on voluntary basis only.
- 3. Participation to this activity is subject to the No-Disruption-of-Classes Policy provided under DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled, "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task an Ensuring Compliance Therewith."
- 4. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, as stated in DO No. 66, s. 2017 (Implementing Guidelines on the conduct of Off-Campus Activities), all must follow the following:
 - a. Ensure relevance and alignment with the educational competencies of the K to 12 Curriculum and leadership Development of learners;
 - b. Uphold child protection principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
 - Observe the safety and security protocols for all participants before, during and after the activity.



Greetings from Philippine Red Cross Aklan Chapter!

For over 72 years, the Philippine Red Cross (PRC) has made a mark in the entire world because of its programs that are designed to address humanitarian challenges, such as disasters, health crisis, and armed conflicts. As of date we have given 9,000 beneficiaries of shelters and livelihood, fifteen (15) units Barangay Health Stations and WASH facilities and twenty one (21) classrooms and other services.

PRC has become a model National Society when it comes to supporting communities affected by disasters and emergencies—from risk reduction to relief and recovery. We earned the respect of the international community because we are able to efficiently deliver humanitarian services out of the contributions and donations received from partners from public and private industries like you.
