PILOT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PHILIPPINE ANTI CAVITY CAMPAIGN (PACC) PROGRAM

1. The Department of Education - Division of Aklan through the School Health and Nutrition Unit, in collaboration with the Colgate Palmolive Philippines Inc. (CPPI) will conduct the Pilot Implementation of the Philippine Anti Cavity Campaign (PACC) Program as part of the Bright Smiles, Bright Futures (BSBF) Program.
2. This aims to provide a comprehensive oral health program that will focus on tooth decay reduction among 1,000 Kindergarten to Grade 3 learners in the division.
3. For school year 2017 - 2018, the Division of Aklan has identified sites for Pilot Implementation; namely: (a) Balete Integrated School, District of Balete, (b) Yapak Elementary School and (c) Caticlan Elementary School Kinder and Grade 1 pupils, District of Malay. They will be given dental supplies such as toothbrushes, toothpastes, oral health education materials and fluoride varnish to the identified beneficiaries.
