PREVENTING DENGUE IN SCHOOLS

To: Chief Education Supervisors
 Education Program Supervisors
 Public Schools District Supervisors
 Heads of Public and Private Elementary, Secondary and Integrated Schools
 Division and School Health and Nutrition Personnel
 All Others Concerned

- 1. There is an urgency of the anti-dengue drive in order to protect the school populace from this disease.
- 2. In view of this concern, all school officials, especially school heads, teachers, and school health and nutrition personnel are advised to disseminate information on the prevention and control of dengue. Close collaboration should be made with the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA), LGU and Barangay/Municipal Health Offices on the conduct of dengue prevention and control activities. Refer to DepEd Order No. 252, s. 2009 entitled "Preventing Dengue H-Fever in Schools" on how to conduct these activities.
- in addition, school heads, teachers, and parents/guardians are advised to let their learners/schoolchildren wear full sleeve shirts, full pants and/or long socks in school to avoid mosquito bites. School officials and personnel are also encouraged to do the same.
- 4. Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
