Acapella is allowed or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment at the composer's discretion (<i>no minus one</i>) 4. Instrumentalists are included as participants. 5. Participants must be students only. 6. No pyro techniques are allowed. 7. Minimal props which is mostly made up of recyclable materials are allowed. 8. Hand movements are allowed but there must be no choreography. 9. Performance is 3-5 minutes only. One (1) point deduction will be made for every 30 seconds exceeded. 9. Cleanliness should be observed after the performance. 10. Contestants must wear their YES-O T-shirt. 11. Lyrics must be submitted during the camp registration typewritten in an A4 size bondpaper in 4copies. 12. The copy of the lyrics shall also be returned after the contest. 13. For Styrofoam: Styrofoam, glue gun, glue sticks and other related materials.</p> <p>C. For Tin Cans: tin cans and other related materials, electrical connections (extension wires)</p> <p>Weighing scale (for excess materials)</p> <p>D. For Tarpaulin: Tarpaulin, scissors, glue, etc.</p>

Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The participants shall be grouped according to the type of recyclable materials. 2. Strictly no pre-assembled accessories are allowed. 3. Strictly no commercial paint is allowed. 4. Only the contestants are allowed in the venue. 5. Participants must maximize the use of recyclable materials brought. The mass of left over material will be determined. The following points will be deducted from the participants after the time allotted: (5-10g = 2 pts., 11-15g = 3 pts. 16-20g = 4pts, 20g-up = 5 pts) 6. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

The camera must have activated date and time setting that will appear on the photo D. The photo must not undergo digital editing and enhancement 4. The contest facilitator shall facilitate and identify only one developing center for the contestants to develop their photos in 8R (8"x11") size. 5. The photos will be displayed in the designated exhibit area with the respective contestants to explain in front of the panel of judges the clear and identifiable message in the photo within three (3) minutes. 6. The allotted time is two (2) hours, after which all entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator. Contestant may also submit his/her poster earlier without waiting for the lapse of two hours. 6. Each poster shall be labelled only with numbers corresponding also to the contestant number.

Rules and Guidelines	1. Each Division will contribute two (2) questions per category written in a ¼ short size bondpaper crosswise. 2. The questions shall be reviewed / screened by EPS II Amelita Pitalgo And EPS II Gemma Mondragon, DepEd Region VI. 3. No substitution of participants in case of absence or emergency. 4. Contestants should wear their ID's. 5. There shall be three main rounds : EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT. 6. Five questions will be given for every round observing the following points: EASY = 1 point, AVERAGE = 2 points, DIFFICULT = 3 points, CLINCHER = sudden death. 7. In case of a tie after the summation of all points across the 3 rounds, a clincher round will be given to determine the top 3 winners observing the sudden death system. 8. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
