

REVISION TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 44, S. 2018, SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) FIRST EXPO AND JOB FAIR 2018

- 1. This is to announce to the field the revisions on the activity SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) FIRST EXPO AND JOB FAIR 2018 per Division Memorandum No. 44, s. 2018.
- 2. The title of the activity is revised to FIRST SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) EXPO AND CARAVAN. This will be held on March 24, 2018, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. at Kalibo Pilot Elementary School (KPES) covered court and grounds. There will be no job fair yet.

- 4. One-day service credit shall be granted to teachers and other entitled personnel who will attend the activity, subject to the provisions of DebED Order No. 53, s. 2003, "Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers."

Travel and other expenses relative to this activity shall be charged against local and other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The expenses of a maximum of five (5) students per school may be charged against local and other funds.
- 6. All other items in Div. Memo. No. 44, s. 2018 shall remain in force.

MECHANICS OF THE FIRST SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL EXPO AND CARAVAN

A. BOOTH

- Each municipality shall put up 1 booth, except Kalibo, Malay, and Batan which shall follow the agreements made during the meeting on March 14, 2018.
- 2. Each booth shall be approximately 2m x 3m. All materials shall be provided by the school.

- 4. This is not a contest.
- Different SHS schools must collaborate to come up with only 1 theme for the municipality.
- 6. Displays:
 - a. SHS products agricultural/marine/fish food products which were produced by students already cooked, **no cooking in the area**
 - i. Appropriate packaging is encouraged
 - ii. May be sold lower than the prevailing price. Proceeds of the sale decided by the school
 - b. SHS outputs (researches, portfolios, leaflets, SHS advocacy materials for distribution, etc.)
 - c. Services foot spa, haircut, manicure/pedicure, massage, etc.
 - d. Multimedia presentation featuring the school's SHS program, immersion video documentaries, research highlights, etc.
 - e. Schools have the options on how they will present their skills, as long as it does not create a "mess" in the vicinity.
- 7. Each school shall be responsible in maintaining the cleanliness and orderliness of their area during and after the activity. It is advised that each school should assign a committee composed of teachers and students to handle this concern.
- 8. School heads should orient their students on proper behavior/decorum.
- 9. Each school should send at least 5 student participants. The number of teacher participants is not limited.
- 10. Because March 23 is a holiday, schools may set up ahead their booths on that day. They should be responsible for the safekeeping of their properties.
- 11. Important: The natural environment of KPES should not be altered. Activities like using nails on trees, cutting/pulling out plants, digging holes, displacing stones from gardens, and the likes are highly prohibited.

B. CARAVAN

- 1. Each municipality shall join the caravan in going to the Expo venue.
- 2. This is not a contest. It is understood that excessive expenses should be avoided.
- 3. Parent's permit should be secured for students who will join the cardvan and the expo.

4. The following groupings are suggested:

- 5. Depending on the distance of the municipality from Kalibo, each group of municipalities should coordinate with one another so that all groups will be at the venue **not later than 8:30 A.M.**
- 6. Drums and other similar instruments may be used during the caravan in order to catch the attention of the public.
- 7. The display of SHS advocacy materials during the caravan is highly encouraged.
