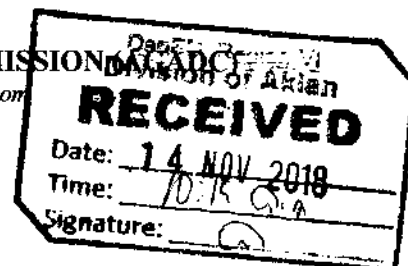

S P O K E N P O E T R Y C O N T E S T

Theme: "VAW Free Community Starts with Me"

Guidelines:

1. Each contestant must be a bonafide Secondary (Junior/Senior High) or Tertiary Student of any school in the Province of Aklan.
2. Each school may send a maximum of two (2) entries.
3. The spoken word piece must be 2-5 minutes long. If it doesn't meet the 2 minute minimum, the performer will be ineligible to place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd. If it goes past 5 minutes, expect to be cut off.
4. Spoken word is a piece of creative writing that is best delivered through performance, so it can be a story, poetry, or some combination. The piece must be your own creative writing, but you can quote other writers. If you reference other authors, your performance must include verbal citations.
5. The Spoken Word Entry may be in English, Filipino, Akeanon or a combination of these languages.
6. The spoken word performance must connect to this year's 18 Day Campaign Theme: VAW Free Community Starts with Me. More information about the theme can be found at this link: <https://aklangadb.wordpress.com/>
7. You may use costumes, props, music, and visual aids to share your spoken word performance. You are also welcome to include dialogue and act out characters.
8. To enter the spoken word competition, the **Entry Form** (attached to this guidelines) must be submitted on or before **November 26, 2018 (Monday), 5PM** at the Provincial Planning and Development Office Special Projects Section (PPDO SPS), 2nd Floor, Provincial Capitol Building, Estancia, Kalibo, Aklan, or send the scanned copy at ppdospecialprojects@gmail.com with Subject: Spoken Word Poetry Entry.
9. The contest will be on **December 12, 2018 (Wednesday)**, Venue and Time to be communicated with your school.
10. Computerized or typewritten Spoken Word Piece must be submitted to the Contest Committee on or before **December 3 (Monday)**, computerized, short bond paper, double spaced, 3 copies, no name of contestant or school. Failure to submit will be grounds for disqualification.
11. All the entries will be properties of the Aklan GAD Commission and can be used as advocacy materials with proper acknowledgement of the authors.

Criteria for Judging:

Phase I: Poetry Writing

Relevance to the theme	- 20%
Creativity/Style and Originality	- 10%
Coherence of form and structure (harmony of words, presentation)	- 10%
Clarity of imagery and language	- 10%

Phase II: Poem Recitation

Stage presence and presentation	- 20%
Poise and spontaneity of recitation	- 10%
Intonation, poetic expression and a clear insight into the poet's intention	- 10%
Clarity of spoken words and diction	- 10%
