THREE-DAY DIVISION SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF ELEMENTARY ARALING PANLIPUNAN TEACHERS

- 1. A responsive curriculum puts premium on its end users which are the learners themselves. In this light, DepEd-Aklan through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a Three-Day Seminar Workshop for Elementary Araling Panlipunan Teachers on December 7-9, 2017 at the 3rd Floor, Kalibo Municipal Building, Kalibo, Aklan.
- 2. The training aims to: update teachers on content knowledge and pedagogy especially in teaching geography; develop critical and creative thinking skills as well as other high-order thinking skills in making assessment; contextualization of learning materials and identify problems and issues which need to be addressed that may have an effect on the implementation of the program.
- 3. Each district will send six (6) Araling Panlipunan teachers comprising of Grades 1-6 inclusive of the District Araling Panlipunan Coordinator.
- 4. The expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity such as meals, supplies, certificates, tarpaulin, reproduction of materials and other related expenses shall be charged against Division INSET Fund, while travel expenses of the participants, trainers and facilitators shall be charged against school/local fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Participation to this activity is subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No.9, s. 2005, entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith". The school head should take the necessary measure to ensure that the teaching load of the Araling Panlipunan Teacher-Participants and Trainers will be taken cared of and NO classes will be missed by the learners.
- 6. Furthermore, trainers and teachers are entitled to service credits where it applies in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled: Updating Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
