1. Please be informed that the Youth Formation Office of the School Governance and Operations Division – DepEd Aklan will launch an online **Tinta: Art Contest**.
2. This contest aims to:
 - a. promote DepEd Core Values among learners and stakeholders;
 - b. provide alternative activity to learners to lessen the possibility of depression and other mental health cases amidst the Covid-19 pandemic;
 - c. motivate learners to be creative and divert their attention to artistic and creative activity; and
 - d. tap potential learners with special skills and talents in visual arts.
3. All public schools, both elementary and secondary, are invited to join the Tinta: Art Contest. For each secondary school, one (1) student per category is allowed, while for elementary level, each district shall only be allowed to submit one (1) entry per category. The Guidelines to this activity are found in the enclosure.
4. It is understood that in the conduct of this event, as stated in the DO No. 66, s. 2017 (Implementing Guidelines on the conduct of Off-Campus Activities), all must observe the following:
 - a. ensure relevance and alignment with educational competencies of the K to 12 curriculum and Leadership Development Learners;
 - b. uphold child protection principles and that no learners shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
 - c. observe the safety and security protocols for all the participants before, during and after the activity.

5. Expenses incurred for the school supplies for this activity shall be charged/sourced from the Special Education Fund of the Province of Aklan, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

Tinta: Art Contest

1. All public schools, both elementary and secondary, are invited to join the Tinta: Art Contest. For each secondary school, one (1) student per category is allowed, while for elementary level, each district shall only be allowed to submit one (1) entry per category.
2. The contest has four (4) categories which are the DepEd Core Values namely, Maka-Diyos, Maka-tao, Makakalikasan, and Makabansa.
3. The artwork must revolve around the theme, "Mag-aaral na Pilipino, Palaban sa Buhay, Gamit ang Puso, Galing at Talino."
4. The size of the artwork must be 210 x 297 millimeters (or A4).
5. The media to be used per category are the following:
 - a. Maka-Diyos – graphite pencil and charcoal
 - b. Maka-tao – pastel
 - c. Makakalikasan – oil/acrylic/watercolor painting
 - d. Makabansa – digital art
6. The contestants must post the following at their personal Facebook account with the subject Tinta: Art Contest, their name, school, district, title of the artwork and hashtags: #depedaklan #depedkabataan2021 #yfdaklan_district (indicate your district) #yfd #tintaartcontest #highschool (to be used by secondary contestants) #elementary (to be used by elementary contestants)
 - a. A clear photo of the artwork
 - b. A picture of the artist holding the artwork
7. The deadline of posting per category are the following:
 - a. Maka-Diyos – April 12, 2021
 - b. Maka-tao – April 13, 2021
 - c. Makakalikasan – April 14, 2021
 - d. Makabansa – April 15, 2021
8. The artwork must be original to the contestant.
9. Upon submission, the artwork shall be managed by this Office for whatever purpose it may serve.
10. Criteria for judging:
 - a. 35% - Relevance
 - b. 25% - Creativity and originality
 - c. 40% - Craftsmanship (overall artistic appearance)
11. Three winners will be selected per category and shall be posted on the official Facebook page of Youth Formation Section, "DepEd Tayo – Youth Formation Aklan."
 - a. 1st Place = Php5,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - b. 2nd Place = Php3,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - c. 3rd Place = Php2,000.00 worth of school supplies
