**TWO-DAY DIVISION ENHANCEMENT TRAINING OF PRIVATE SCHOOL
GRADE 10 ARLING PANLIPUNAN TEACHERS ON CONTEMPORARY ISSUES**

1. The Department of Education through the Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct the Two-Day Enhancement Training of Private School Grade 10 Araling Panlipunan Teachers on Contemporary Issues on December 1-2, 2017 at 3rd Floor, LGU Municipality of Kalibo, Aklan.
2. The training aims to equip teachers with functional understanding of the Curriculum Framework, Learning Standards and Competencies and Assessment of Contemporary Issues as an essential part of Araling Panlipunan Curriculum, Gain knowledge on how the Contemporary Issues Learner's Module and Teaching Guide can be best utilized during the course implementation and identify problems and or issues which need to be addressed that may have an effect on the implementation of the program.
3. Each complete private secondary school will send one (1) grade 10 Araling Panlipunan teacher. No registration fee. Transportation and other relative expenses of the trainers and staff is chargeable to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participation to this activity is subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy as stipulated in DepEd Order No.9, s. 2005, entitled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith". The school head should take the necessary measure to ensure that the teaching load of the Araling Panlipunan Teacher-Participants and Trainers will be taken cared of and NO classes will be missed by the learners.
5. Furthermore, trainers are entitled to service credits where it applies in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s.2003 entitled: "Updating Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers".
6. Participants are encouraged to bring laptop and 8GB USB Flash Drive.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
