  - c. Observe the safety and security protocols for all participants before, during and after the activity.

Scout Leaders who will participate in the said activity are entitled to Service Credits where they apply in accordance with **DepEd Order No. 53, 2003** entitled: "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers". On the other hand, non-teaching personnel including the management staff shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 02, s. 2004 on Non-Teaching Monetary Renumeration for Overtime Service Rendered.
