**Subject: Webinar Training on Basic Occupational Safety and Health (BOSH)**  
**for the Expanded Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Classes**

The Department of Education (DepEd) and the Department of Health (DOH) have signed the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 01, series of 2021 or the *Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Limited Face-to-Face Learning Modality* issued last 27 September 2021.

Section 7.1.1.4.10 of the JMC states that *“the school shall mobilize the School COVID-19 Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Team to ensure that health and safety protocols are in place and are observed during the preparation and implementation of the face-to-face classes. The School DRRM Team shall also designate a Safety Officer who shall serve as the focal person for the health and safety protocols of the school.”*

In concurrence with the said provision and in preparation for the expansion of limited face-to-face classes, all Regional DRRM Coordinators shall coordinate with the regional offices of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) to request for the conduct of **Training on Basic Occupational Safety and Health (BOSH) for all designated School Safety Officer**. The Regional DRRM Coordinators shall also facilitate all logistical requirements for the training including coordination with the DepEd offices and key personnel concerned.
