

**WORKSHOP ON REVISION, POLISHING AND FINALIZATION OF CONTEXTUALIZED
LEARNING AND ACTIVITY MODULES IN SCIENCE 3 TO 6**

1. The K to 12 Science curriculum is learner-centered and inquiry-based, emphasizing the use of evidence in discussing concepts and constructing explanations. In view of this, there is a need to develop learning and activity modules that apply hands-on or experiential learning and make use of materials available in the locality.
2. In response to such need, contextualized modules were developed by teachers. To ensure quality outputs, there is a need to review, polish and finalize the modules prior to publication. Hence, a live-out **Workshop on Revision, Polishing and Finalization of Contextualized Learning and Activity Modules in Science 3 to 6** will be conducted on **August 16 to 18, 2018** at the **Aklan State University - College of Industrial Technology (ASU-CIT) Function Hall, Kalibo, Aklan**.
3. The participants are the Education Program Supervisor - Science, selected master teachers and module writers who submitted their drafts. The names of the teacher-participants are listed in Inclosure No. 1 of this memorandum.
4. The expected outputs from this workshop are contextualized learning and activity modules in Science 3 to 6 which will be submitted for possible publication to the LRMS portal. Authorship of the modules will be credited to the writers.
5. The participants are advised to bring with them laptop and extension wire, internet connectivity device with load, Science curriculum guide, teachers' guide and learners' materials, textbooks and other reference materials.
6. School heads concerned are reminded of the "no disruption of classes" policy. Appropriate measures should be implemented in order to ensure that make up classes

shall be held by teachers who will participate in this activity. Also, adjustments in class schedules may be made so that the learners of these teachers are taken cared of.

7. No registration fee shall be charged. Travel expenses and other allowable expenses, however, may be charged against local/school board funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Participants to this workshop will be given **one-day service credit** (Saturday) as per DepED Order No. 53, s. 2003.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum to all concerned is strongly desired.
