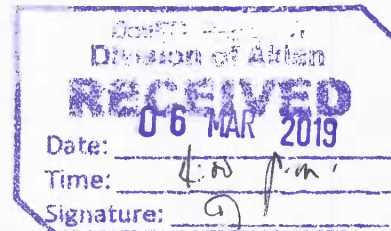

The Local Government of Kalibo is currently preparing as we approach the 122nd commemoration of the death of our freedom fighters, the pioneers of the propaganda campaign of the Katipunan in Panay Island and who were instrumental in the cessation of atrocities committed towards the patriots of the Province of Aklan.

Guidelines:

1. Each contestant must be a bonafide Secondary (Junior/Senior High) Student of any school in the Province of Aklan.
2. Each school may send a maximum of two (2) entries.
3. The spoken word piece must be 2-5 minutes long. 1 point deduction for every minute undertime/overtime.
4. Spoken word is a piece of creative writing that is best delivered through performance, so it can be a story, poetry, or some combination. The piece must be your own creative writing, but you can quote other writers. If you reference other authors, your performance must include verbal citations.
5. The Spoken Word Entry must be Akeanon.
6. The spoken word performance must connect to the life of the XIX Martyrs of Aklan.
7. You may use costumes, props, music, and visual aids to share your spoken word performance. You are also welcome to include dialogue and act out characters.
8. To enter the spoken word competition, the **Entry Form** (attached to this guidelines) must be submitted on or before **March 8, 2019 (Friday), 5PM** at the CBIS Radyo Natin Office, 2nd Floor, Kalibo Municipal Building, Magsaysay Park, Poblacion, Kalibo, Aklan, or send the scanned copy at lgupublicaffairs@gmail.com with Subject: Binaeay-bay Entry.
9. The contest will be on **March 23, 2019 (Staurday), 5PM**, at Kalye Kulinarya sa Kalibo (KKK), Veterans Ave., Poblacion, Kalibo, Aklan (at the back of DRSTMH).
10. Computerized or typewritten Spoken Word Piece must be submitted to the Contest Committee on or before **March 15 (Friday)**, computerized, short bond paper, double spaced, 3 copies, name of contestant and school shall be printed at the back of the first page of your entry. Failure to submit will be grounds for disqualification.
11. All the entries will be properties of the Local Government Unit of Kalibo and can be used as advocacy materials with proper acknowledgement of the authors.

Criteria for Judging:

Phase I: Poetry Writing

Relevance to the theme	-	20%
Creativity/Style and Originality	-	10%
Coherence of form and structure (harmony of words, presentation)	-	10%
Clarity of imagery and language	-	10%

Phase II: Poem Recitation

Stage presence and presentation	-	20%
Poise and spontaneity of recitation	-	10%
Intonation, poetic expression and a clear insight into the poet's intention	-	10%
Clarity of spoken words and diction	-	10%
TOTAL	-	100%
