- 1. Relative to DepEd Oder No. 72. S. 2003 titled **Constitution and By-Laws** of the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O) this office, through the School Governance and Operations Division - Youth Formation Office, will conduct the **YES-O Project Innovation** from March to June 2022.
- 2. This activity intends to:
 - a. improve the participants' knowledge, skills, and attitude towards planning and be able to use the process to make their program, projects, and activities successful;
 - b. establish specific and doable programs, projects and activities to address issues and concerns on the environment and ecology;
 - c. encourage community participation and initiative in environmental and ecological movements and actions; and
 - d. provide participants a venue for collaborative and integrative projects, ideation, formulation, and critique of the dynamic, feasible, doable, and concrete plan of activities and social innovations for implementation in the schools.
- 3. The participants to this activity are Secondary School YES-O Officers together with their Teacher-Advisers.
- 4. The Teacher-Adviser shall secure Annex A Parental Consent for the student participants.





- 5. Adherence to the health protocols (Refer to D.O. No. 14, s. 2020 Guidelines on the required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools) of every participant shall be strictly observed.
- 6. Participation to this activity is subject to compliance with DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 with the following guidelines:
 - a. Ensure relevance and alignment with the educational competencies of the K to 12 Curriculum and leadership Development of learners;
 - b. Uphold child protection principles and that no learner shall be disadvantaged in any form; and
 - c. Observe the safety and security protocols for all participants before, during and after the activity and should follow the **existing policies and guidelines on off-campus activities** (DepEd Order No. 66,s. 2017).
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

YES-O PROJECT INNOVATION

- 1. The Public Schools District Supervisor will select one secondary school to participate in the said contest and shall submit an application and endorsement form, and parental consent using the link bit.ly/YESOIP22 on or before February 28, 2022.
- 2. The participant/s to this activity are School YES-O Officers from the selected secondary schools and the contest is to create a proposal and sustain a project that is related to the objectives of this contest.
- 3. The challenge will start in March 2022 and participant/s shall post 3-7 minutes of documented video at their DepEd Tayo - Youth Formation School Page on June 1, 2022 with the subject: YES-O PROJECT INNOVATION, school, district and hashtags: #depedaklan #depedkabataan2022 #yfd #YES-O #projectinnovation
- 4. The video must be informative, instructional, and/or entertaining and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
- 5. Criteria:
 - a. Methodology (promotion of ecologically friendly practices & approaches) 30%
 - b. Quality and aesthetic impact (presentability of the output) 10%
 - c. Sustainability (period or time frame per harvest and plan of action) 30%d. Social Impact (adaptability to the community) 20%

 - e. Cost efficiency (minimal or no expenses incurred) 10%
- 6. The following are the modes of verification:
 - a. Methodology video of the process involved in operation of the project
 - b. Quality and Aesthetic impact video of the result of the project

 - c. Sustainability project timelined. Social Impact feedback of member/s of the school/community
 - e. Cost efficiency utilization of recyclable materials
- 7. There shall be top three (3) winners and shall be awarded of the following prizes:
 - a. 1st Place = Php5,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - b. 2nd Place = Php3,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - c. 3rd Place = Php2,000.00 worth of school supplies
 - d. Special Category: People's Choice Award = Php1,000.00 worth of school supplies
- 8. The most number of views will be selected on June 8, 2022 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning.
- 9. Other expenses incurred in the operation of the YES-O Project Innovation will be shouldered by the implementers. Linkage with LGUs, government agencies and NGOs for support and sustainability is encouraged.
- 10. Failure to comply with any requirements set by the guidelines will automatically lead to disqualification.
