YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT IN SCHOOLS ORGANIZATION (YES-O) DAY

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2011, entitled "Strengthening Environmental Education in Public and Private Schools," Republic Act No. 9512, entitled "An Act to Promote Environmental Education and for Other Purposes," and Presidential Decree No. 1153, entitled "Requiring the Planting of One Tree Every Month for Five Consecutive Years by Every Citizen of the Philippines," DepEd Aklan will conduct the **Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O) Day** at Numancia Covered Court, Numancia, Aklan on January 31, 2020 with the theme: *"YES-O SHINES (Safety and Health Information Network for Environmental Sustainability)."*
2. The activity specifically aims to:
 - a. Inculcate among students the critical role of environmental protection in preventing and coping with the effects of climate change such as typhoons, floods, earthquakes, and droughts;
 - b. Develop students' awareness on the state of the environment, focusing on significant issues and concerns;
 - c. Motivate actual involvement of students in the worthwhile programs and projects for the environment;
 - d. Strengthen the implementation of the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O);
 - e. Ensure students and pupils' active participation and determine action in the protection, preservation and rehabilitation of the environment and conservation of the natural resources in their respective areas; and
 - f. Foster camaraderie and brotherhood among participants.
3. Participants to this activity are selected public and private secondary YES-O Officers and members with their respective YES-O Advisers (science/other related subject teachers) with a maximum of fifty (50) participants, one Teacher-Adviser is to fifteen students, and District Youth Formation Coordinator per District.
4. The Teacher-Adviser shall secure **Enclosure No. 1 – Parental Consent** for the student participants.
5. The District Youth Formation Coordinator (DYFC) shall accomplish online pre-registration form: <http://deped.in/yesoday> on or before **January 27, 2020**. There shall be one entry per category. This means that district level elimination shall be conducted if there are two or more entries in a category. Elimination shall be facilitated by the DYFC.

OBJECTIVES	To showcase the student's care and love for the environment through their creative and musical skills.
No. of Required Participants	10-15 participants per division
Composition	Any grade level
Duration of the Performance	3-5 minutes
Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The lyrics must be original written in Filipino and must be theme based. Adaptation of melody is allowed. 2. Acapella is allowed or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment. 3. Instrumentalists are included as participants. 4. No pyro techniques allowed. 5. Choreography is allowed but limited only to hand movements (participants should be stationary). 6. Performance is 3-5 minutes only. One point deduction will be made from the average score for every 30 seconds exceeded and 5 points deduction for any violation of the above mentioned rule. 7. Participants should wear their Division YES-O t-shirt only. 8. Lyrics in four (4) copies should be submitted during the registration. 9. The judge's decision is final and irrevocable.

No. Of Required participants	6-8 participants per division (any grade level)
Duration of the Performance	3-5 minutes
Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be environment-related interpretative dance. 2. Only environmental song may be used and the participant may choose any song to mashup. 3. No pyro techniques allowed. 4. One-point deduction will be made for every 30 seconds exceeded. 5. Cleanliness should be observed after the performance. One (1) point deduction for violation of the said rule. 6. Only bodily props are to be used. 7. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
