1. The Department of Education, Division of Aklan, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), Alternative Learning System (ALS) Unit, will conduct the **Alternative Learning System (ALS) Program Implementation Review (PIR) and Team Building Activity** at Boracay Tropics, Boracay Island, Malay, Aklan, on March 6-8, 2024.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. Review the following ALS components: curriculum contextualization, literacy mapping, learner assessment tools, monitoring and evaluation framework, learning resource development, and system support components such as capability building, advocacy and social mobilization, partnerships strategies, and inclusion of ALS in school-based management;
 - b. Determine the extent of Presentation Portfolio Assessment (PPA) implementation, including the milestones, gains, and challenges incurred; and
 - c. Present the findings, recommendations, and best practices of ALS Teachers.
3. Participants in this activity are ALS Education Program Supervisor, Education Program Specialists II, ALS Teachers, ALS-SHS Coordinators, Community ALS Implementers and selected IP learners of Malay.
4. All Districts must prepare a 5-minute PowerPoint/Video with the following contents:
 - a. Enrolment for SY 2023-2024 as of February 6, 2024, in the Basic Literacy Program (BLP), Accreditation and Equivalency Program for



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- Elementary and Junior High School level, and Senior High School, categorized by track and strand, gender and by ALS Teacher;
- b. Comparative number of enrolments and completers for the SY 2021-2022, 2022-2023 & 2023-2024 categorized by ALS program and gender based on the LIS Data, considering enrollment trends, best practices, bottlenecks, barriers, and interventions;
 - c. Age Profile of learners by Program and by Gender;
 - d. Number of teachers handling ALS-SHS (for Altavas, Kalibo II and Numancia only)
 - i. Full time ALS-SHS teachers
 - ii. Formal JHS or SHS teachers teaching Full Time in ALS
 - iii. Formal Elementary, JHS, or SHS teachers with teaching load in both formal and ALS;
 - e. Issues and concerns, hindering and facilitating factors in the implementation of ALS Programs; and
 - f. ALS-related activities, best practices and plans for SY 2024-2025.
5. Enclosed are the Matrix of Activities and the List of Participants for your information and guidance.
6. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity such as accommodation, meals, training materials, and other allowable expenses are chargeable against the downloaded ALS 2023 Program Support Fund (PSF), while travelling expenses are charged against MOOE/local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination in the provision of learning and development interventions on account of age, school, gender, civil status, disability, religion or other similar factors or personal circumstances that run against the principles of equal opportunity.

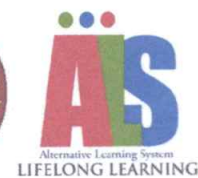
