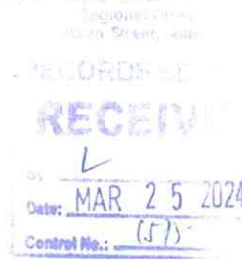

SUBJECT : ONSET OF THE WARM AND DRY SEASON

The retreat of the High-Pressure Area (HPA) over Siberia indicates an apparent weakening of Northeast Monsoon (*Amihan*). Furthermore, the strengthening of the North Pacific High has led to the gradual shift in the wind pattern from northeasterly to easterly and an increase in the air temperature over the parts of the country. These signify the end of the Northeast Monsoon (*Amihan*) and the beginning of the **warm and dry season**. In the coming months, the number of the dry and warm days across the country will continue to increase, although the isolated thunderstorms are also likely to occur, usually in the afternoon or evening.

Hence, the public and all concerned government agencies are advised to continue their ongoing precautionary measures to minimize heat stress, optimize the daily use of water for personal and domestic consumption, and prevent any accompanying health risks associated with this climate condition.

In this regard, all concerned government agencies and the public are advised to take the following preparedness measures:

REGIONAL DRRM MEMBER AGENCIES:

1. Undertake risk-form decision-making;
2. Undertake Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment (PDRA) and other related meetings as needed;
3. Undertake resource inventory and stockpiling as RDRRMC Response Clusters; and
4. Implement water conservation measures.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS:

1. Undertake and implement science and evidence-based decisions within your area of responsibilities (AOR) in the conduct of PDRA;
2. Prepare critical facilities and services;
3. Maximize the Local DRRM Funds;
4. Increase capabilities for logistics requirements;
5. Adhere to the LISTO Protocol of DILG; and
6. Implement water conservation measures.
