- 2. Ensure the participation and registration of your LGU's delegation for the event;
- 3. Ensure that the required documents are legitimate and submitted on time;
- 4. Bearer of the login credentials for accessing the Batang Pinoy Games Registration System;

- 5. Attend to all concerns regarding the participation of their team in validation, accreditation, registration and releasing of IDs;
- 6. Be the only recognized official for the Delegation Registration Meeting (DRM);
- 7. Sole authorized receiver of identification cards of all the delegates during the DRM:
- 8. Ensure the safety and well-being of your LGU's delegation throughout the duration of the event

Please email a signed appointment letter from your mayor or governor (whichever applies) to **batangpinoy@psc.gov.ph**, along with the contact information of your designated HOD and DHOD by July 15, 2024. Failure to provide the necessary information and appoint an HOD and DHOD by the given deadline may result in a delay in your LGU's registration via the Batang Pinoy Games Registration System.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 44, series of 1998, the Philippine Youth Games - Batang Pinoy was created to address the need for a comprehensive grassroots program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play. The

Philippine Sports Commission under the Office of the President leads the annual

conduct of the Philippine Youth Games - Batang Pinoy.

This year, the PSC will hold the Batang Pinoy National Championships 2024, a nationwide youth sports competition, from December 15 to 21, 2024, in Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. The competition will feature 27 sports and will be participated by student-athletes who are 17 years old and below, representing 149 cities and 82 provinces in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao.

Relative thereto, all Governors and City Mayors are highly encouraged to participate and support the competition. Moreover, all Governors and City Mayors are requested to designate a Head of Delegation and a Deputy Head of Delegation. Names and contact numbers of the designated HoD and DHoD shall be sent through a letter signed by the LCE to batanqpinoy@psc.gov.ph. The HoD and DHoD will serve as primary points of contact for all official communications and updates from the organizers, shall ensure the legitimacy and timeliness of the required documents for submission, will be the bearer of the login credentials to access the BP Games Registration System, will attend to all concerns regarding the participation of their team during validation, accreditation, registration and releasing of identification cards, among other responsibilities. The Philippine Sports Commission will no longer honor the participation of officials sent by Provincial and City Governments without proper communication through the designated HoD.

All DILG Regional Directors are hereby directed to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular to all LGUs within their respective jurisdictions.
