## GUIDELINES FOR RESEARCH PAPER PRESENTATION AND POSTER COMPETITION

### Activity: ORGANIC RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM

Date: November 21, 2024

Venue: Central Philippine University, Jaro, Iloilo City

Theme: "Kabuhayang OA, Kinabukasang OK: PGS Pinalakas para sa Bagong Pilipinas."

#### A. RESEARCH PAPER

1. The following are the criteria for the research paper presentation::

2. Presenter is allotted only 15 minutes for research paper presentation.

3. Submit e-copy of research paper thru email ad: [jswendam@cpu.edu.ph](mailto:jswendam@cpu.edu.ph) on or before **November 11, 2024**, and also three hard copies of the full paper for the members of the panel. You may bring the hard copies during the presentation on **November 21, 2024**.

4. Confirmation of participation is required on or before **November 11, 2024**.

#### B. RESEARCH POSTER

Organic Research Poster should clearly depict rationale/significance, objectives, methodology (the specific approaches, strategies, and/or innovation applied or experienced), discussion/ interpretation, conclusion, policy implications, and recommendations; and should adhere to the following format/guidelines:

1. The poster should both be attractive and self-explanatory – presenting organized and concise key ideas, conclusions and recommendations..
2. Poster should be 40" x 30" (in portrait format) with labels not exceeding 600 words.



3. The design should flow sequentially from one part to the next (left to right or top to bottom). Number of arrows may be used to help the eye move from item to item in the correct order. Avoid cluttering with text or artwork.
4. Poster text should be presented in no more than three colors. Dark typed in light background is easier to read.
5. Photographs/illustrations should be 5" x 7". Captions and labels should be readable from two meters away and not cluttered with unnecessary details. Graphs are preferable to tables. Use only one vertical scale per graph.
6. The poster must be set-up/displayed in the designated area (CPU Promenade) a day before the symposium proper (November 20, 2024) and must remain on display until the Awarding Ceremonies in the afternoon of November 22, 2024.
