CRM E-POSTER MAKING CONTES

- Pictures sourced from the internet ere allowed to be used provided that they are free to use or have been granted permission from the owner to use them
- The submitted poster must have been originally created by the participants. For submissions with copyright issues, the committee has all the rights to disqualify the entry at any time.
