SUBJECT : **VISAYAS HUMANITARIAN ACTION WORKSHOP**

1. With the Philippines as one of the most prone-disaster countries in the world (since it is located along the boundary of major tectonic plates and at the center of a typhoon belt), the Visayas Cluster, BSP will conduct the **Visayas Humanitarian Action Workshop** with details as follows:
Date : **March 13-16, 2025**
Venue : **Filamer Christian University**
Roxas City, Capiz
Host : **Capiz Council, BSP**
2. Aims and objectives of the Workshop: This workshop is aimed at enhancing strategies in humanitarian action, clarifying the role of Scout Leaders during the disaster response and benchmark best practices of BSP following the laws of humanitarian action.
3. Target Participants: All local councils are required to send two (2) participants (CSE/FSE, Adult Leaders) and submit the **List of Participants** on or before **28 February 2025**.
4. Registration Fee: A registration fee of **TWO THOUSAND PESOS (Php2,000.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for meals (from dinner of March 13, 2025 until lunch of 16 March 2025), materials and administrative cost.
5. All expenses such as Registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses on this travel shall be chargeable against scouting funds/local funds/MOOE/SEF, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Things to Bring: Participants are advised to bring the following: **Type A Uniform, Smart Casual and Beddings**.
